Scholarships

White River Electric Association has the availability to administer 3 separate funds for providing scholarships to graduating high school senior dependents of White River Electric Assn., Inc.; members who wish to further his /her academic or vocational training. The scholarships you are eligible to apply for are as follows:

- White River Electric Scholarships. The number of awards and amounts to be determined by the Board of Directors year to year.
- 2 \$500 scholarship that are for 1-time dispersal only. These are funded by Tri-State Generation & Transmission and will be selected by White River Electric Scholarship Committee.
- 2 \$1,250 scholarships that are for 1-time dispersal only. This is funded by Basin Electric and will be selected by White River Electric Scholarship Committee.

You only need to submit 1 application for consideration of all scholarships.

These scholarships will be available to qualifying, graduating seniors whose parents or guardians are members of White River Electric Association, and who plans to continue his/her education at a college or vocational school. (Preference will be given to electric related fields).

Scholastic ability and potential for success in a chosen field may also be considered, in addition, students must complete their high school career with a final transcript grade of a 2.0 cumulative G.P.A. or better or any awards may be rescinded.

Completion of this application and, if you are selected to interview, your presence at the interview appointments will be required for consideration of this scholarship. Applicants will be notified of their appointment times by phone, letter, or school announcements.

Any financial aid awarded from White River Electric Scholarship funds will be remitted to the institution of attendance and will be credited to the students account, presumably at the beginning of the college school year. It will be the responsibility of the student to inform White River Electric of the address and when the payment should be made. The scholarship monies are to be used for tuition, books, or room and board expenses.

The selection committee shall consist of the Board of Directors of White River Electric.

All applications are due February 4, 2026, by 4:30 p.m. and must be returned in person, email (wrea@wrea.org), or by mail to:

The award recipient shall be notified by mail, and a certificate will be presented at graduation.

Requests for each year's renewal must be in writing/email, accompanied by a transcript of grades for the entire year, and proof of full-time student status.
